Dear Enthusiast,

On behalf of the Society, may I extend a cordial invitation to you to submit an entry in one or more of the Scheduled List of Classes (see overleaf). As in previous years a professional security guard will be mounted throughout the event.

The Event is authorised by the National Traction Engine Trust and will be subject to their Code of Practice.

Due to the popularity of the event, it has become necessary to restrict the size of the classes. Selection of exhibits will be carried out on a first come basis and if classes are over-subscribed, a selection committee will ensure the greatest variety of exhibits.

Expenses are as itemised overleaf on the Scheduled List of Classes and will only be paid to exhibitors appearing on both days of the Event and whose exhibits are catalogued; the expenses and commemorative memento will be available after 17.00hrs on Sunday. Please ensure that you select the appropriate class.

**Exhibits not appearing on both days of the event and not on display from 10.00hrs until 17.00 hours will be excluded from next years event. All exhibits in classes marked \* overleaf are to parade in the arena with the exhibitor dressed in the appropriate costume for the exhibit.**

A panel of judges will make an assessment of the exhibits from 10.00hrs on Saturday and awards and trophies will be presented to the most meritorious entries.

**CAMPING:-** If any exhibitor wishes to have visitors camping with them on the exhibitors camp site they must apply, in writing, at the time of making their entries for their guest passes etc. This is the only time that consideration will be given to visitors accompanying exhibitors on the camping site.

The cost for visitors will be £20.00 per unit and their admission charges are £24.00 per adult and £20.00 concessionary, children are free (under 15 years of age) for the full weekend.

Because of Insurance restrictions no exhibitors or visitors are permitted to camp on the rally field or campsite until **noon on Thursday 26th July**. Please ensure you make alternative arrangements if you were proposing to arrive before 26th July.

The Organisers reserves the right to reclassify the entry forms and also to return unacceptable entries together with the reason for rejection.

Please return the completed entry form as soon as possible to aid the processing of the forms.

**The closing date for exhibit entries is  
31st MARCH**

Current and proposed legislation means that in some areas changes have had to be made and all exhibitors are encouraged to familiarise themselves any changes relevant to themselves and their exhibits. (i.e. Road Traffic Act, Electricity at Work Regulations, Driving Licenses, Insurances, Vehicle Licenses, Towing Regulations etc.)

**IMPORTANT NOTICE** - In the interest of safety, the riding of motorcycles, tractors or any other **mechanically** or **electrically** propelled machine by **under-aged, unlicensed or uninsured persons** will not be tolerated at any time on the event site.

Cycling by any person, other than identified stewards is prohibited.

Any under-aged or uninsured driver/rider, together with their accompanying responsible party, will, without question or exception, be excluded from the event.

**DECLARATIONS:**

**A. Steam Vehicles**

I declare that if my exhibit is authorised for use on the public highway, that during the period of the event, when the general public have access, my exhibit will be covered by the minimum insurance requirement as required by the Road Traffic Act, irrespective of whether my exhibit is licensed or not. If my exhibit is not authorised for use on the public highway it will be covered by a Public Liability Policy and by a Boiler Explosion Policy, both policies having a limit of indemnity of not less than £2.000,000 in any one accident and sparks and ashes cover for not less than £100.000.

I further declare that the boiler of any steam plant carries a Boiler Inspection Certificate and I will produce documentary evidence of such insurance and inspection to you before participating in the event. **I further declare that the driver/s hold a driving licence of the appropriate class and will produce, if required, such licence. NTET Insurance Disc Scheme is obligatory this year.**

**Note:- All drivers of steam vehicles will be required to be capable operators.**

**All steam entries are to be in steam by 09.00 hours on both days of the event, to take part in the planned displays and activities.**

**B. All other Exhibits**

I declare that during the period of the event, when the general public have access, my exhibit if authorised for use on the public highway will be covered by the minimum insurance requirement as required by the Road Traffic Act irrespective of whether it is licensed or not. If my exhibit is not authorised for use on the public highway it will be covered by a Public Liability Policy having a limit of indemnity of not less than £2.000,000 in any one accident. **I further declare that the driver/rider of any exhibit authorised for use on the public highway holds a driving licence of the appropriate class for the exhibit.**

I agree to produce the insurance and licence documents to the Safety Officer if requested.

**C. All Exhibitors**

I agree to produce, on request, an Inspection Certificate in accordance with the IEE Regulations for any electrical equipment (ie generators, wiring, appliances).

I agree to abide by the Rally Organisers Code of Practice of the National Traction Engine Trust and The Society's written Statement of Safety Policy - copies of which are available for inspection in the Rally office.

I agree to operate my exhibit during the event and comply with the instructions of Stewards. In the event of a dispute the Event Organisers decision is final.

I agree to wear costume appropriate to my exhibit whilst parading the Arena.

I agree to ensure that my exhibit/exhibits will be displayed from 10.00hrs until 17.00hrs on both days of the event.

# CUMBRIA STEAM GATHERING, CARK AIRFIELD, FLOOKBURGH

## Rules & Site Information

1. Rubbish - Bins are provided at strategic points and will be emptied regularly. Please take your waste to the bins and ensure that litter does not blow about the site.
2. Water - Drinking water is available from the large road tankers on the campsite or the standpipe near the main toilet block.
3. Toilets - Chemical toilets must NOT be emptied into the mobile toilets: a designated disposal point is situated at the main toilet block.
4. Shop - The shop at the entrance to the exhibitors campsite supplies milk, bread, newspapers and a large range of items you may need during your stay at Flookburgh.
5. PARKING - Any vehicle, not part of a display or exhibition may not be parked on the rally field. Ample car parking is available at no cost. See map.
6. Speed - A maximum speed limit of 5 mph is in force at all times over the entire site, during the build up, the event and break down times.
7. SAFETY - Applicable at all times including build up and breakdown times. In the interest of safety, the riding of motorcycles, tractors or any other mechanically or electrically propelled machine by under aged, unlicensed or uninsured persons, will not be tolerated. **BE WARNED** - That any under aged driver/rider, together with their accompanying responsible party, will without question be excluded from the event. Insurance documents and licenses will be checked. As a result of many complaints the riding of any cycle, not part of an exhibit, by ANY PERSON is prohibited. Any person riding cycles and their accompanying party will be excluded from the event. The only exception will be identified stewards going about their duties.
8. Dogs - Dogs are welcome but owners should ensure they are under control at all times and faeces should be picked up by the owner in the interest of public hygiene and risk of disease to the farm animals which graze the site.
9. Private generators - Please ensure that these are silenced whenever possible, and switched off at **Midnight** to ensure other campers are not disturbed by the noise. **This will be strictly enforced.**
10. Generators installed by the organisation **MUST NOT** be touched by any unauthorised persons (life-support systems may be dependant on these generators).
11. Trespass - We are very fortunate to have extremely tolerant neighbours. However, their privacy must be respected and no person should leave the site by any route other than the official gates.
12. Fire - All traders, caterers and exhibitors should have their own fire extinguishers capable of dealing with caravan electrical/fuel fires. All open/enclosed cooking arrangements should be supervised at all times when in operation, especially barbecues. These should be completely extinguished on completion of the cooking. If a fire breaks out, clear the surrounding area immediately to prevent spreading and inform the rally organiser or stewards.
13. Crime/Vandalism - Will not be tolerated. Please carry out a "neighbourhood watch" duty and report any theft or vandalism to the police, the security patrols or the event organiser.
14. Noise & Anti-Social Behaviour- Please respect other persons on site and keep unnecessary noise to a minimum, especially at night. Miscreants will be excluded from the event.
15. Movement of Vehicles - Unnecessary movement of vehicles should be avoided in the interests of safety and for the preservation of the grassland sward which can be cut up by vehicle movement.
16. Lost Children - A certified group will have a marquee near to public entrance gate A and they have provision to take care of lost children. Child identification bracelets will be available at the pay gates - free of charge. Any child found to be lost should be taken to this point preferably by an identified steward, or Police Officer.
17. First Aid - St John's Ambulance Service have a presence on site. Accidents and incidents should be reported to the Secretary's Office for recording, as is required by law.
18. Departure - Please delay departure as long as possible to alleviate traffic problems and minimise aggravation to yourselves.
19. Please co-operate with the stewards in taking up your allocated camping area, keep the area tidy and do not obstruct the access routes.
